Annexure A

Technical Specifications:

The required specifications and terms & conditions are as follows:

- 30 Mbps dedicated internet bandwidth. Cost for 50 Mbps may also be indicated in the same quotation.
- 8 usable non-listed public IPs.
- Primary line with the same bandwidth, working alongside a secondary line with no IP change during failover, and the failover process should be autoswitching.
- Both primary and secondary lines should be in a 1:1 ratio.
- Remote end latency should be between 1ms to <5ms on both lines, even under load.
- Backup connectivity must be provided through different ring/network path from the primary path.

Terms & Conditions

1. The quotation should clearly indicate installation charges, recurring charges, applicable taxes, and any other incidental charges.
2. Vendors should provide details regarding SLA, uptime commitment, response/resolution time for complaints, and technical support facilities.
3. The vendor should specify the installation/commissioning timeline, contract period, and escalation matrix for service-related issues.
4. The quoted rates should remain valid for a minimum period of 90 days from the date of submission.
5. Vendors should submit copies of GST Registration, PAN Card, and relevant licences/authorisations.
6. Preference may be given to vendors having prior experience in providing dedicated leased-line internet services to academic/research institutions or similar organisations.
